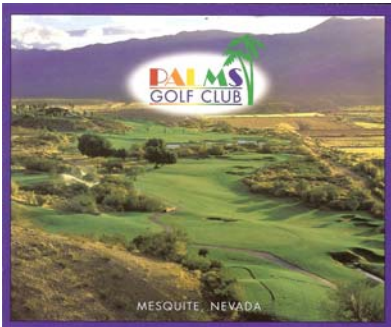

April Tournament

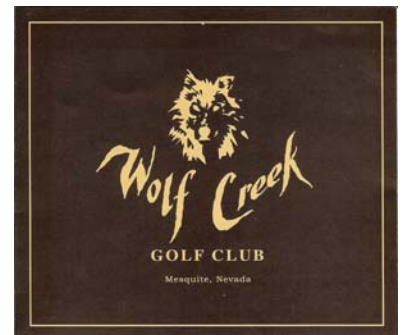
The April Tournament is a Two-Man Scramble, with drawing of A and B Players. Scramble rules are as follows: Both team members tee off and the best drive is selected. Both team members move their ball to the spot of the selected drive, and play their second shots from there. The procedure is repeated until the ball is holed out.

Other suggestions for tournaments:

Las Vegas - Example: On team A, one team member has a 4, the other a 5. The two member team score for the hole would be a 45. The points per hole is determined by the difference between the two team scores. If team A scores make a 45 and team B scores make a 55, the difference is 10 points. 55-

45=10. Team A would win 10 points for the hole

Nassau - The front nine holes make up the first match, the back nine another, and the 18 hole total making the third match

Sixteen - Use Net scores. Each hole has a total point value of 16 points. Players earn points as follows:

Best score:7 points, Second best score 5 points, Third Best score 3, Fourth score 1 point. Tie scores split points. $7+5 = 12$ so score 6 point, $5+3 = 8$ so score 4 points, $3+1 = 4$ so score 2 points. If all tie than all four players get 4 points.

US Open entries close on April 26th, so you'd better get your applications in soon. This year's US Open will be at Winged Foot, Mamaroneck, NY, June 15-18.

It is too late to volunteer for the 2006 US Open; however, if you are interested in volunteering for the 2007 U.S. Open Championship, please complete online application as soon as possible.

All volunteers will be required to purchase the volunteer package for \$150. As part of the volunteer package, all volunteers will receive the volunteer uniform and a credential valid for all

seven days of the Championship. The volunteer uniform will consist of two logoed golf shirts, a windshirt and a hat. Payment is NOT required at this time. The 2007 U.S. Open Championship Office will notify you if you have been selected as a volunteer. At that time, each selected volunteer will receive his or her committee assignment and an invoice for the total amount of the volunteer package. You can pay by mail or will be able to log back into this Web site and pay online.

I volunteered for the 2007 US Open, which will be held at Oakmont Country Club, and I will also be volunteering for the 2008 US Open at Torrey Pines.
