- Greater than a triple bogey will count as -6.
- Triple bogey -4.

- Double bogey -2.
- Bogey 0.
- Par +2.
- Birdie +4.
- Eagle or better +8.

The highest four places will be calculated. Last year's winner totaled 44 points, so never give up and never give in. A few good holes can make all the difference, as the scoring is forgiving on blowup holes and rewarding on those exceptional shots.

USGA News

The USGA website states that Clubs will only be required to renew their license to the USGA Handicap System during each cycle of the USGA Handicap System manual. Furthermore, the USGA will consider participation in a USGA Handicap Seminar from 2002 forward as satisfying the seminar attendance requirement for 2006-2007.

From that point forward, each USGA Handicap System manual cycle will last four years and coincide with the Quadrennial Rules Conference process for the Rules of Golf (2008-2011, for example).
